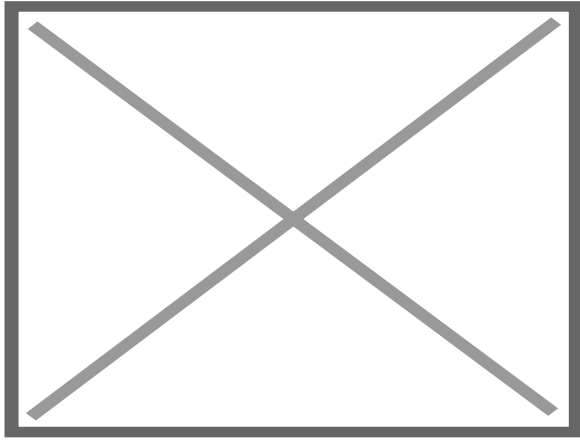


Indianhead Ski Trip / End of Season
